

2010 FUSION WHITE AN EXCEPTIONAL VIOGNIER-BASED WHITE WINE BLEND

Fusion is a carefully created modern blend that has its roots in the ancient past. Steve Borra's grandfather used the traditional method of planting to create a field-blend combination of grapes in a single vineyard that work together to blend his wine. After harvesting the vineyard, the blend was already made, with each varietal contributing a special element of flavor and character to the wine.

Steve Borra is a time-honored, traditional Italian winegrape-grower, using modern-day advances to nuture his vines. Each vineyard block is harvested only when perfectly ripe, with lots vinified separately, leveraging the latest in highend winemaking techniques.

Tasting Notes

Our Rhône Viognier fuses with a pinch of German Gewürztraminer to produce bright, tantalizing aromas of floral lemon, grapefruit and orange with a backbone of wet stone minerality, shifting to peach and white pepper as it warms from an ideal 55° serving temperature. Chock-full of concentrated cream of lemon, peach and walnut with a light brushing of lemongrass and spicy anisette on the finish. One of the few wines we know that can dance harmoniously with asparagus. Even better with a catch of fresh Shrimp Scampi.
